


Public libraries in Missouri are able to purchase from Missouri's statewide contracts.

The library must be part of the State of Missouri's Cooperative Procurement Program. Libraries can verify whether or not they are included on the current Cooperative Procurement Program Members Listing at <u>https://oa.mo.gov/sites/default/files/coopmemlist.pdf</u>.

If not, you can register by completing the Cooperative Procurement Program Membership Application. at <u>https://oa.mo.gov/purchasing/procurement-program-membership-</u> <u>application</u>.

You can search for Missouri's state contracts at <u>https://oa.mo.gov/purchasing/bidding-contracts/awarded-bid-contract-document-search</u>.

Public libraries that choose to purchase from a state contract do not need to complete a large purchase cost analysis for the item(s) on grant applications.



Most frequently, we see public libraries purchasing technology through the state contract. Currently, this contract is held by SHI.
