ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On November 15, 2017, the Enforcement Section of the Securities Division of the Office of Secretary of State (the “Enforcement Section”), through Enforcement Counsel Derek Green, submitted a Petition for Order to Cease and Desist and Order to Show Cause why Restitution, Civil Penalties, and Costs Should not be Imposed (the “Petition”). On November 27, 2017, the Enforcement Section filed an Amended Petition. On December 11, 2017, the Missouri Commissioner of Securities (“the Commissioner”) issued an Order to Cease and Desist and Order to Show Cause why Restitution, Civil Penalties, and Costs Should not be Imposed (the “C&D Order”). On September 13, 2018, the Enforcement Section filed a Motion to Dismiss.

Upon Petitioner’s Motion, this matter is dismissed, effective September 13, 2018.
