ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Now on the 19th day of January, 2016, the Commissioner, having reviewed this matter, issues the following findings and order:

FINDINGS AND ORDER

- 1. On May 17, 2011, Petitioner filed a Petition for Order to Cease and Desist and Order to Show Cause why Restitution, Civil Penalties, and Costs Should not be Imposed ("Petition") in AP-11-13, against SPC Brands, Inc., Spectrum Pet Care, Spectrum Pet Foods, Inc., Consolidated Food Group, Inc., and Frank Renick.
- 2. On May 19, 2011, the Commissioner issued an Order to Cease and Desist and Order to Show Cause why Restitution, Civil Penalties, and Costs Should not be Imposed ("Order to C&D").
- 3. On June 20, 2011, Respondent Frank Renick ("Renick"), through Respondent's counsel, filed a Request for Hearing.
- 4. On June 22, 2011, Respondents SPC Brands, Inc., Spectrum Pet Care, Inc., and Spectrum Pet Foods, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Spectrum") through Respondent Spectrum's counsel, filed a Request for Hearing.
- 5. On December 14, 2011, Respondent Spectrum, through Respondent Spectrum's counsel, filed a Waiver of Request for Hearing.
- 6. On June 14, 2012, Respondent Renick, through Respondent Renick's counsel, filed a Waiver of Request for Hearing.
- 7. Consolidated Food Group, Inc. ("CFG"), was a California corporation. Renick was the

president of CFG. The corporate status of CFG has been suspended for failure to meet tax requirements.

- 8. On June 17, 2012, Respondent Renick died.
- 9. On December 16, 2015, the Commissioner granted Petitioner's Motion to Sever Respondents CFG and Renick. As a result, the case involving Respondent Spectrum was assigned case number AP-11-13a, while the case involving the Respondents CFG and Renick was assigned case number AP-11-13b.
- 10. On December 29, 2015, the Enforcement Section, by and through Assistant Commissioner of Securities Mary S. Hosmer, filed a Motion to Dismiss Respondents CFG and Renick.
- 11. Respondents Consolidated Food Group, Inc. and Frank Renick are hereby **DISMISSED** from this case.
