

This section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: One comment was received.

COMMENT: William Stalter commented that the provisions of section (4) require evidence of deposit coverage by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC). However, the statute provides that the account shall be insured by FDIC or comparable deposit insurance. Mr. Stalter asked whether the statute is intended to allow the use of accounts other than bank accounts so long as those accounts are insured with deposit insurance comparable to that of the FDIC or in an account that is in a state or federally chartered financial institution authorized to do business in Missouri and located in Missouri. Mr. Stalter further questioned if segregated accounts at savings and loan associations or brokerage firms could be used if they have deposit insurance and are authorized and located in Missouri. Mr. Stalter went on to state that brokerage firms insured by Securities Protection Insurance Corporation (SPIC) and questioned whether cemeteries could comply with the requirements of Section 214.330.2 by using brokerage accounts which provide SPIC coverage. Mr. Stalter further stated that the proposed rule would also require evidence that the attorney has escrow powers in the state of Missouri. Section 339.600 exempts all attorneys licensed in the state of Missouri from the requirements of escrow agents. Accordingly, it would seem appropriate that the proposed regulation required evidence that the attorney is licensed in Missouri and that the license is in good standing.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The board agreed with Mr. Stalter's comments regarding comparable deposit insurance and attorney escrow powers and made changes to section (4) of the rule. However, since the board is unable to give legal advice, the board directed Mr. Stalter to consult with his own legal counsel regarding his legal question concerning comparable deposit insurance. The board stated that the office currently has the legal opinion that brokerage accounts are not bank accounts, therefore, SPIC would not be comparable to FDIC. It is also the board's understanding that all savings and loan associations now fall under the FDIC.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The Division received one letter with several comments regarding the proposed amendment, as detailed below. The Division also revised the amount of the per patient day NFRA assessment from the \$7.55 in the proposed amendment to \$7.50. This change is being made to reflect the actual patient days to be assessed based on the December, 1999 quarterly survey.

COMMENT: Section (F) should be amended with an ending date of June 30, 2000 and section (G) should be amended with an ending date of June 30, 2001, if that is an accurate date.

RESPONSE: The Division does not feel it is necessary to indicate an ending date for either subsection (2)(F) or (G). The proposed amendment set forth in subsection (2)(G) indicates that the NFRA will change at July 1, 2001. The Division will amend the rule for any future changes in the NFRA, indicating the date and amount of the change.

COMMENT: The period for the fiscal note should be clarified.

RESPONSE: The revised fiscal note indicates an annual cost of \$120,103,433, which is the twelve-month cost of the amendment beginning July 1, 2000.

COMMENT: The fiscal note does not take into consideration that the rate increase is being put into place one quarter early.

RESPONSE: The Division prepared the fiscal note with the intent that the rate increase be effective July 1, 2000.

Senate Bill 577 was passed by the 2000 General Assembly and recently signed into law by the governor. Language contained in the bill at 260.395.1(3), RSMo requires that Missouri's hazardous waste transporter license fee consist of an annual application fee plus an annual usage fee. In accordance with this change to the law, effective August 28, 2000, the basis for assessing license fees on hazardous waste transporters will change from the current system to a system that includes both an annual application fee, plus a usage fee based on hazardous waste tonnage, mileage, or both. To fully implement these changes to the law, the Missouri Hazardous Waste Management Commission is in the process of proposing the necessary amendments of the rule listed above.

It is anticipated that the rule to establish the amount of the annual application fee component and the amount of the usage fee component will be adopted by the fall of 2001. In the interim, immediately after August 28, 2000, the department will implement a temporary licensing fee system consisting of an annual application fee in an amount equal to a fee based on the current licensing system. The department will waive the usage fee component of the license fee until the implementing rule is adopted by the commission. The implementing rule will also establish the amount of the annual application component, but in the interim that component will be calculated using the current licensing system. This will allow the department to continue issuing licenses to hazardous waste transporters during the period that the implementing rule is being developed and adopted.

Therefore, until the rule is adopted, hazardous waste transporters needing to obtain a new license or to renew an existing license will be assessed a license fee in an amount equal to the fee due under the existing system. On an interim basis, this fee will constitute the annual application fee component of the revised licensing system. Collection of the usage fee will be waived until the necessary rule is adopted. The commission invites public comments on this proposal or on the implementation of the usage fee.
