STATEMENT OF ACTUAL COST

5 CSR 30-4.030 Audit Policy and Requirements

The original estimated cost and fiscal note for the public cost to this rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on November 1, 2002 (27 MoReg 1938–1940). The cost to state agencies and political subdivisions has exceeded the cost estimate by more than ten percent (10%). Therefore, pursuant to section 536.200.2, RSMo 2000, it is necessary to publish the cost estimate together with the actual cost of the first full fiscal year. The estimated cost was \$3,500,165 and at the end of the first full year, the actual cost to state agencies and political subdivisions was \$3.9 million for Fiscal Year 2002–03. This increase is not truly related to the changes in the audit rule for the following reasons:

- (1) In addition to the following audit regulations specified in this rule, school audit reports must also follow current accounting reporting regulations. The Governmental Accounting Standards Board issued Statement #34, which changed the reporting requirements for governmental entities. This new reporting requirement was to be implemented through a phase-in period based on the FY 1999 revenues (exclusive of special and extraordinary revenues). Less than twenty (20) schools implemented Statement #34 for FY 2001–02. Approximately one hundred (100) additional schools were required to implement the new reporting requirements for FY 2002–03, which drove the audit costs up for those districts. All remaining schools will have to implement the Statement for 2003–04 and, therefore, the audit fees for 2003–04 will most likely increase again for this reason.
- (2) Several schools had extra audits conducted by the State Auditor's Office because of a petition filed by their local taxpayers. There is not a separate code for schools to charge these costs to so they are included in the 6315 object code on the Annual Secretary of the Board Report (ASBR). Petition audits do not replace the regularly required independent audit—they are in addition to—and the costs of the petition audits are sometimes considerably more than the regularly required independent audit.
- (3) Auditors may have been requested to help the district with other specific accounting or reporting issues and such costs may be included in the same object code as the actual audit fees paid to the auditor. The department has no way of knowing when or if this occurs or what the amount of such services might be.
- (4) There were several new charter schools for FY 2002-03 which would have incurred audit fees which were not taken into consideration when anticipating audit-related costs.

For these reasons, it is very difficult to determine the actual fiscal impact of the audit rule. There were not any substantial changes to the requirements for regular school districts. The main revision to

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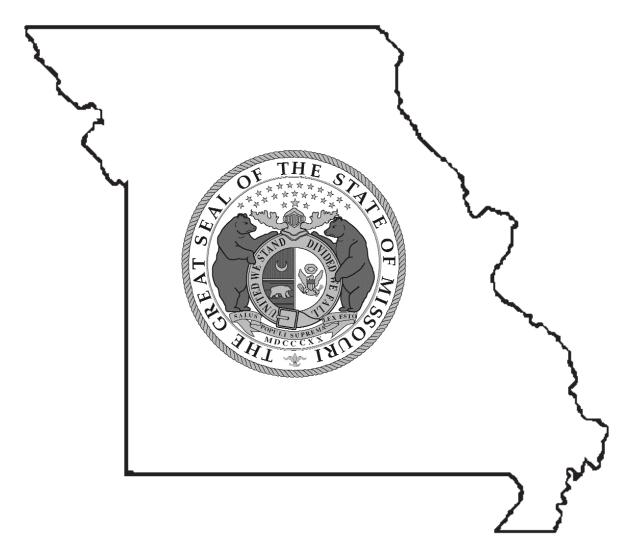
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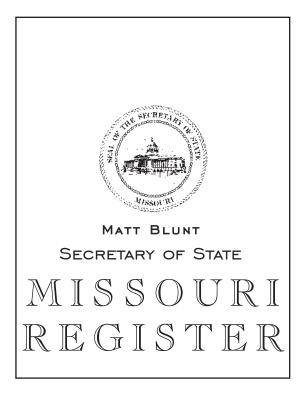
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
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
