



FILING REQUIREMENTS UPDATE

As a reminder, the Secretary of State's office requires:

- 11 or 12 point type for rule text on your rule filings;
- use of only one side of the paper; and
- a stamped transmittal on top of each original and each copy of every rule filing.

The office has also reduced the number of copies required for filing rules. Agencies are now required to provide an original and only one copy at SOS. The exception is emergency rulemakings that require an original and two copies.
