Subsection is (A) with further breakdown into paragraph 1., subparagraph A., part (I), subpart (a), item I. and subitem a.

**EXECUTIVE ORDER
14-04**

WHEREAS, I have been advised that on-going and forecast severe storm systems have caused, or have the potential to cause, damage associated with tornadoes, high winds, heavy rain, hail, flooding and flash flooding impacting communities throughout the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the severe weather that began on April 2, 2014, and is continuing, has created a condition of distress and hazard to the safety, welfare, and property of the citizens of the State of Missouri beyond the capabilities of some local jurisdictions, and other established agencies; and

WHEREAS, the State of Missouri will continue to be proactive where the health and safety of the citizens of Missouri are concerned; and

WHEREAS, the resources of the State of Missouri are needed to assist affected jurisdictions and to help relieve the condition of distress and hazard to the safety and welfare of our fellow Missourians; and


WHEREAS, an invocation of the provisions of Sections 44.100 and 44.110, RSMo, will be required to ensure the protection of the safety and welfare of the citizens of Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JEREMIAH W. (JAY) NIXON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Missouri, including Sections 44.100 and 44.110, RSMo, do hereby declare that a State of Emergency exists in the State of Missouri. I do hereby direct that the Missouri State Emergency Operations Plan be activated.

I further authorize the use of state agencies to provide assistance, as needed.


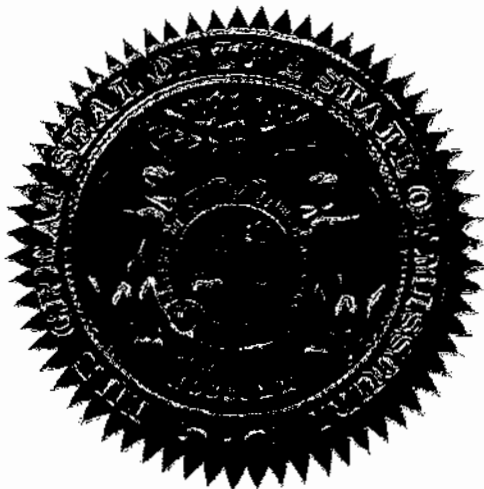

Under this heading will appear the text of proposed rules and changes. The notice of proposed rulemaking is required to contain an explanation of any new rule or any change in an existing rule and the reasons therefor. This is set out in the Purpose section with each rule. Also required is a citation to the legal authority to make rules. This appears following the text of the rule, after the word "Authority."

Entirely new rules are printed without any special symbolology under the heading of proposed rule. If an existing rule is to be amended or rescinded, it will have a heading of proposed amendment or proposed rescission. Rules which are proposed to be amended will have new matter printed in boldface type and matter to be deleted placed in brackets.

An important function of the *Missouri Register* is to solicit and encourage public participation in the rulemaking process. The law provides that for every proposed rule, amendment, or rescission there must be a notice that anyone may comment on the proposed action. This comment may take different forms.

If an agency is required by statute to hold a public hearing before making any new rules, then a Notice of Public Hearing will appear following the text of the rule. Hearing dates must be at least thirty (30) days after publication of the notice in the *Missouri Register*. If no hearing is planned or required, the agency must give a Notice to Submit Comments. This allows anyone to file statements in support of or in opposition to the proposed action with the agency within a specified time, no less than thirty (30) days after publication of the notice in the *Missouri Register*.

An agency may hold a public hearing on a rule even though not required by law to hold one. If an agency allows comments to be received following the hearing date, the close of comments date will be used as the beginning day in the ninety- (90-) day-count necessary for the filing of the order of rulemaking.

If an agency decides to hold a public hearing after planning not to, it must withdraw the earlier notice and file a new notice of proposed rulemaking and schedule a hearing for a date not less than thirty (30) days from the date of publication of the new notice.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

6 CSR 10-2.140 Institutional Eligibility for Student Participation.
The commissioner of higher education is amending section (1).

PURPOSE: This amendment defines "located in Missouri" for purposes of establishing institutional eligibility to participate in state student assistance programs.

(1) Definitions.

(H) Located in Missouri shall be any institution with a main campus, as determined by its institutional accrediting agency, located in Missouri and that is the basis of its U.S. Department of Education recognized institutional accreditation, or that meets

all of the following criteria:

1. The institution has established and continuously maintains a physical campus or location of operation in the state;

2. The institution is accredited by a regional accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education;

3. The institution agrees to seek and maintain voluntary certification to operate and comply with reasonable data requests from the department;

4. The institution employs at least twenty-five (25) Missouri residents, at least one-half (1/2) of which are faculty or administrators engaged with Missouri operations;

5. The institution enrolls at least seven hundred and fifty (750) Missouri residents as degree or certificate-seeking students; and

6. The institution maintains a Missouri-based governing body or advisory board with oversight of Missouri operations.

[(H)](I) Standard admission policies shall mean policies approved and published by the approved institution to admit students to the institution.

[(I)](J) State student assistance program shall be any financial aid program created by Missouri statute that charges the CBHE with program administration and that establishes institutional eligibility through criteria consistent with section 173.1102, RSMo, as determined by the CBHE.

PROPOSED RULE

13 CSR 40-7.035 Participant Verification

PURPOSE: This rule outlines how the Department of Social Services will verify participant information in order to administer the Family MO HealthNet programs and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

(1) Scope: This regulation specifies how the Department of Social Services shall verify participant information in order to administer the Family MO HealthNet programs and CHIP to prevent fraud and insure the integrity of the Family MO HealthNet programs and CHIP.

(2) The "Federally Facilitated Marketplace" is created under section

1321(c)(1) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (Public Law No. 111-148) as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law No. 111-152).

(3) The Department of Social Services shall access the electronic data hub, as defined in 13 CSR 40-7.010, to verify information provided by the participant as part of the application process for Family MO HealthNet programs and CHIP. The department shall only verify the following:

- (A) Citizenship;
- (B) Immigration status;
- (C) Income using Internal Revenue Service information;
- (D) Income from Title II benefits information from the Social Security Administration;
- (E) The number of work quarters from Social Security Administration;
- (F) Employment information; and
- (G) Confirm current enrollment in a MO HealthNet program.

(4) The Department of Social Services shall also use the electronic data hub to send information on participants who are not eligible for Family MO HealthNet programs and CHIP to the Federal Facilitated Marketplace to verify if the participants qualify for advance payment of premium tax credit; cost-sharing reductions or qualified health plans. The Federally Facilitated Marketplace will use the electronic data hub to send information to the Department of Social Services to verify if participants qualify for Family MO HealthNet programs or CHIP or to verify if a participant is already enrolled in Family MO HealthNet programs or CHIP.

(5) The Department of Social Services will not use, duplicate, or disclose any information used or obtained under this rule to any individual, organization, state or federal agency for any purpose not related to the public assistance benefits administered in whole or in part by the Department of Social Services as that phrase is defined in section 205.967.1(1), RSMo. All applicable state and federal laws and regulations governing the confidentiality of public assistance programs, health information, and taxpayer information shall govern the use or disclosure of information shared with or obtained from the electronic data hub.

(6) All information used or obtained under this rule, unless otherwise prohibited by this rule, shall be destroyed in accordance with section 208.125, RSMo, unless otherwise required by law.

AUTHORITY: section 208.990, RSMo Supp. 2013. Original rule filed April 8, 2014.

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rule will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rule will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

*NOTICE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS: Anyone may file a statement in support of or in opposition to this proposed rule with the Family Support Division, PO Box 2320 Jefferson City, MO 65102-2320. To be considered, comments must be received within thirty (30) days after publication of this notice in the **Missouri Register**. No public hearing is scheduled.*

Verification of a medical examination that includes tests for communicable diseases including, but not limited to, tuberculosis and hepatitis when recommended by a licensed physician, completed by a licensed physician, certified nurse practitioner, advanced practice nurse in a collaborative practice agreement with a licensed physician, or a registered nurse who is under the supervision of a licensed physician, for all staff working directly with children shall be submitted utilizing the form prescribed by the division;

2. A current board roster, including the mailing address and place of employment of each member and a list of board officers;

3. A summary of any significant changes to programs and copies of any resulting policies or policy changes;

4. A copy of a current organizational chart;

5. Annual results of a check of the family care safety registry for all staff, as well as interns, volunteers, and contractors. Any employee who resides in another state and works in the state of Missouri, or who has relocated to the state of Missouri within the last five (5) years, shall provide documentation of child abuse/neglect and criminal background screening check(s) from those states. If the employee

continues to reside in another state, the out-of-state check shall be done annually. Results of employee medical examinations and background screenings, along with family care safety registry documentation, may be viewed by division licensing staff on site during routine record reviews;

7. A record of monthly drills for fire and emergency evacuations which are held at different times of the day and night;

8. Documentation that each operating site's water supply and sewage disposal system is currently in compliance with the requirements of the Department of Health and Senior Services if not an approved public source;

9. A copy of the most recent financial audit and/or financial review pursuant to 13 CSR 35-71.040(5)(B);

10. A copy of the annual written staff training plan;

11. Documentation that each operating site food service is currently in compliance with requirements of the Department of Health and Senior Services or any local applicable ordinance;

12. A copy of the current personnel and/or program manual for the agency if there have been changes since last submitted to the licensing unit;

13. For any agency operating a swimming pool on grounds, documentation that the pool is operated and maintained in accordance with all applicable local ordinances and/or state guidelines;

14. A copy of the resume of all administrative and professional staff, if not previously submitted to the licensing unit;

15. Documentation of insurance for the agency for professional liability and commercial liability, worker's compensation insurance, fire and disaster insurance, and agency vehicle insurance; and

16. Documentation of form 990 for all non-profit agencies and Internal Revenue Service return for for-profit agencies and self-disclosure of tax liabilities, including but not limited to all employee withholding taxes.

It reads: “Full- or part-time professional staff including psychologists, psychiatrists, social workers, counselors, physicians, teachers, and nurses shall meet the licensing or certification requirements of their profession in Missouri.” This rule addresses NASW’s concerns regarding professional licensure. As a result, no changes have been made to the proposed amendment.
