

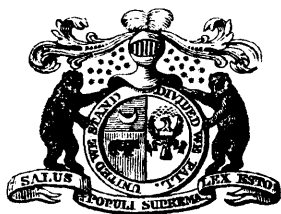

THE STATE OF MISSOURI,

To all, ^{who shall see} to whom these Presents shall come—GREETING:

WHEREAS The Register and Receiver of the United States, Western Land District, appointed under the provisions of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, entitled "an act to provide for the sale of the Seminary Lands," have made out and forwarded, in pursuance of said act, an abstract of all the Seminary Lands sold in said District, under the provisions of the act aforesaid, by which it appears, that John Cook of the county of Jackson of the State of Missouri did, on the fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, purchase the West half of the North East quarter of Section fourteen Township forty nine Range thirty-two containing eighty acres, and hundredths of an acre, being a part of said Seminary Lands, at the price of two dollars and cents per acre, amounting in the whole to One hundred and Sixty dollars and cents; And whereas, it further appears from the final certificate of said Receiver, that said John Cook has made full payment of the purchase money, to him the said Receiver, for the above described tract of land; NOW, KNOW YE, that the State of Missouri, in consideration of the premises and in pursuance of the provisions of said act, has given and granted, and by these presents does give and grant unto the said John Cook and his heirs, the above described tract of land, to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said John Cook his heirs and assigns forever.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, ^{Daniel Dunklin} JOHN MILLER, Governor of the State of Missouri, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and have hereunto set my hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at the City of Jefferson, the third day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-~~two~~^{three}, of the Independence of the United States the ~~twelfth~~^{seventh}, and of the State of Missouri the ~~twelfth~~^{thirteenth}.
