9<sup>th</sup> August 1842

Dr Sir

I received your letter respecting cer-  
tain claims due for services rendered in the  
Mormon difficulty, but not in time to see  
you in Fayette the name of James Williams  
stands on the payroll unpaid which is \$ 11.07  
also Hugh Parsons unpaid . . . . . 11.07  
but the name of James L. Simpson is not  
to be found on the original payroll in  
Capt Childs company. I expect to be  
in the City of Jefferson about the last of this  
month at which time I will pay off the  
above claims and any others that you may  
have on hand. The out standing claims  
are often presented to me for payment and  
cannot leave home until about that time  
lest I should disappoint many persons  
my respects to your self and family
