and the cries of infant children that
you ~~has~~ read this and forth with your

your Petitioner a Release from this
Confinement with out any further
trouble and send me a reply by the
next day so doing you may save the
Lives of innocent women and infants that
-are should you do so your servant
will be exceedingly Grateful to your
Excellency and for this your Petition
earnestly Pray yours with Respect.
