Sec. 8226, Revised Statutes, 1909. *Penalty for Failure to Record or Return License.* * * * Every officer or person who shall fail to return a License within ninety days after the issuing of the same, or who shall make a false return thereon, or any Recorder who shall willfully make a false record of any marriage license or return thereon, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than five or more than one hundred dollars.

Sec. 4728, Revised Statutes, 1909. * * * And every person not authorized by law to solemnize marriages who shall falsely represent that he is so authorized, and who, by any pretended marriage ceremony which he may perform, shall deceive any innocent person or persons into the belief that they have been legally married, shall, on conviction, be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one year, or by fine not less than five hundred dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
